Patients are unable to join the group once it has started; they can however attend the monthly drop-in to address their grief whilst waiting for the next group to start.</p> <p>- SCARS group (for patients with body image and relationships after cancer)—2 sessions for men and 2 sessions for women; 2 hours per session; ongoing running service.</p>
