## FIT – British Society of Gastroenterology Guidance:



Thank you to all our PCNs for the work you have done to increase the use of FIT in the lower GI referral pathway. There has recently been some British Society of Gastroenterology Guidance released.

Could we please ask that you continue to use FIT for high and low risk referrals as previously discussed. We will notify you if we change any of the pathways in GM but at this stage please carry on doing the great work & continue to use and follow the guidance / processes we previously shared.

Briefing note and FIT infographic re-shared along with this bulletin.

The Cancer Alliance are expecting further guidance from the NHS Cancer Programme imminently and will share this with PCN leads as soon as we have it.



### Searches for EMIS; SystmOne & Vision; Cancer Diagnosis Without Fast Track Referral:

GM Cancer Alliance have worked with the GM Shared Services Primary Care Data Quality Team to produce a search to identify cancer diagnosis without fast track referrals.

This will be set up on all GP systems in GM (arrangements to be made with Wigan and Trafford where GMSS input differs to the other 8 localities) – The search will be available on systems to run from July onwards.

Please encourage Practices in your PCN to use the search to review these patients and improve referral practice.



#### Translated 2ww Referral Letters for Patients:

GM Cancer Alliance have translated the 2ww referral letter available on GP systems into various different languages. The letters have been shared with GM Shared Services Primary Care Data Quality Team for installation.
