Persistent back pain

Numbness waist down

Tingling to hands and feet.

#### 'Rising health concerns'

2+ stone weight loss

Raised BP & blood sugar

Insomnia (due to pain)

Painful legs giving way

Chest pain

COVID responsible?

Tony unconvinced

#### **Treatment**

8 ½ hour surgery

Radiotherapy.

## **Diagnosis**

Plasmacytoma



#### 'Let down'

No Macmillan follow-up

No GP contact

'Alone' 'Not allowed to have my family with me'

Diagnosed alone

#### 'False reassurance'

3 GP presentations - advised wear and tear', 'nothing to worry about'.

Required sooner

#### **Primary Care Support**

Communication required.

### **Macmillan Support**

Before 8 weeks & for entire family.

**Collaboration within the Care Network** 

Avoid re-arranging follow-up care

Diagnosed alone

#### 'False reassurance'

3 GP presentations - advised 'wear and tear', 'nothing to worry about'.

### <u>'I had a breakdown on</u> <u>the ward'</u>

Lengthy admission likely with a long rehabilitation at another hospital

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
