

Cervical Screening Training for GPs

The following document aims to outline the training requirements and recommendations for GPs who wish to undertake Cervical Screening. All UK registered health professionals involved in cervical screening must keep up to date with developments in the programme and meet their professional obligations for continuing professional development.

Requirements

- All sample takers must be registered on the <u>MFT Cervical sample takers database</u> (<u>CSTD</u>) with a current GMC PIN
- All sample takers must be aware of all current cervical screening guidelines, including the <u>sample acceptance policy</u>, and guidelines for women outside of the screening programme (for example those who present with <u>abnormal vaginal bleeding</u>) <u>Cervical screening: programme and colposcopy management - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)</u> <u>Population screening programmes: NHS cervical screening (CSP) programme - detailed</u> <u>information - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)</u>
- All sample takers must <u>use electronic requesting</u> to request cervical screening samples and only use paper requests in the event of an IT failure. Email: <u>labs.sd@mft.nhs.uk</u> Telephone: 0161 276 4079
- All sample takers require access to <u>Open Exeter</u> to obtain accurate screening histories

Recommendations: It is strongly recommended that GP sample takers complete a recognised novice sample taker training course to enhance their specialist training

- If sample takers take an extended leave of absence it is recommended that sample takers complete eLearning and <u>undertake supervised practice</u>

If the above training is not undertaken: it is recommended that sample takers complete the following eLearning modules, and consider supervised practice with an experienced sample taker

- <u>eLearning for healthcare</u> free modules on <u>cervical screening programme</u> and <u>HPV</u> <u>primary screening</u>
- Thinprep training (<u>Via MFT CSTD</u>)

Evidence of completed training should be added to the CSTD

Update training should be undertaken every 3 years and is available via eLFH or RCG
