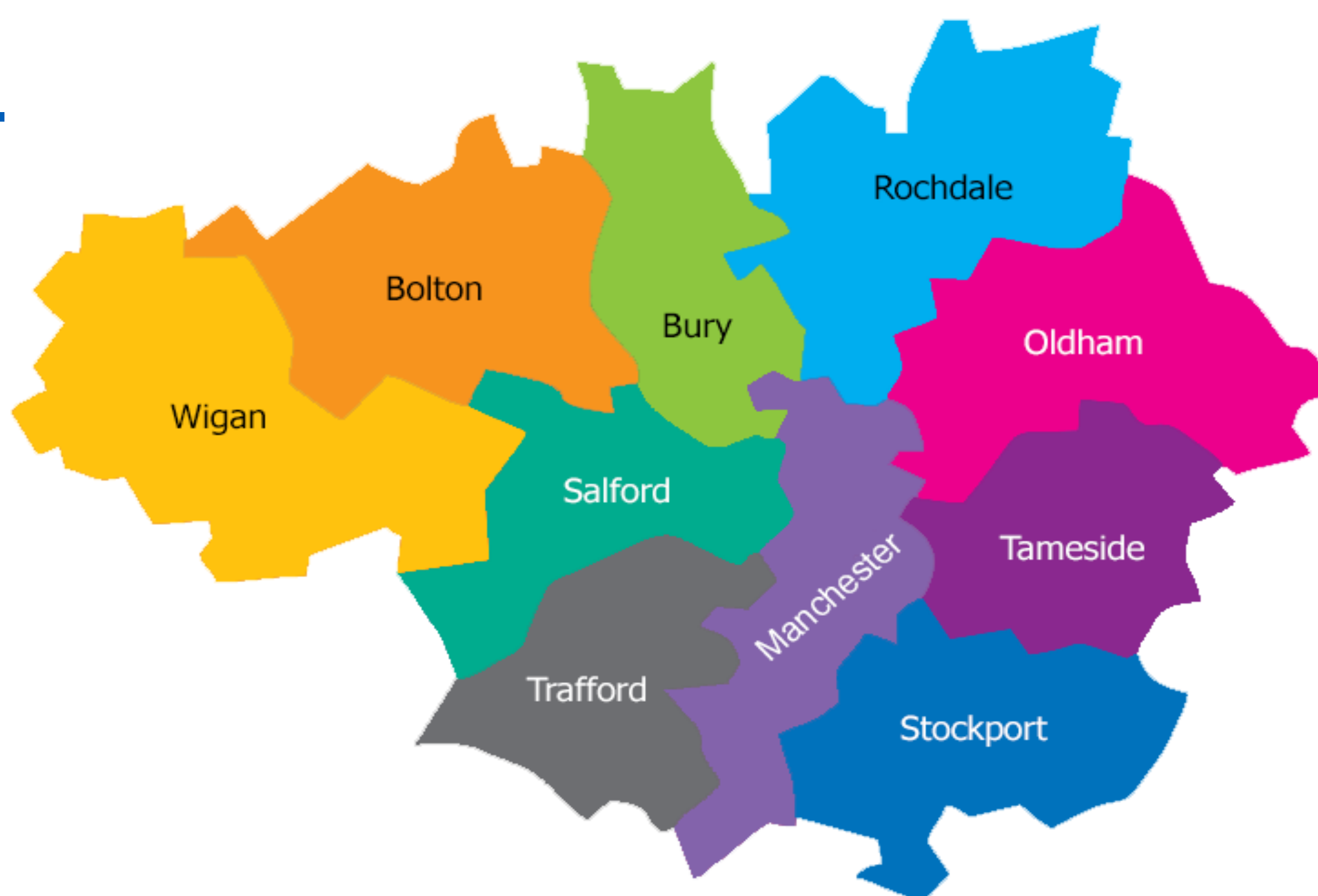


**In May 2021 Mayor Andy Burnham pledged in his manifesto to create a holistic, specific “Live Well with Cancer” programme in Greater Manchester.**
