





### **Why we are writing to you**

Your doctor told you today you need to go to hospital to have some checks.

**You need to be seen urgently within 2 weeks.**

- **See a specialist to have a test** – this might be a test with a camera





## Why you need this check

We need to check you don't have a serious condition like **cancer**.

Most people who have this check **do not have cancer**. But we need to check early so we can give you treatment if you need it.

## What happens next

The hospital will get in touch to set up an appointment.

Please call your GP if you **haven't heard anything in 10 days**.

**It is very important you go to your appointment.**

## Tests you might have

You might need to have



- ⇒ blood tests
- ⇒ X-rays
- ⇒ scans on your body
- ⇒ camera tests

We will tell you what you need to do before the appointment.

## What happens after the tests



You will get the results **on the same day**.

The specialist at the hospital will talk to you

- ✓ about your results
- ✓ what happens next

You can bring someone with you if you want to.

This can help if you have questions or want to talk about your results more.
